



★ Management Team Roles - indicator ★

Overview

The *MTR-i™ (Management Team Roles—indicator)* course enables a group of team members to see how their individual contributions relate to the overall team products and improves team interaction and performance through increased understanding and appreciation of each other and identification of team strengths and weaknesses.

Each member of the team individually completes the *MTR-i™* questionnaire, which is a stand-alone psychometric instrument underpinned with Jung's theory of psychological type. The *MTR-i™* questionnaire measures what a person is doing in the team, how they are behaving at this time – not what they prefer to do or used to do.

Following explanation of the eight *MTR-i™* team roles and interpretation of the team's results, the team then work together to identify and build on their team strengths and identify and mitigate team weaknesses.

Learning Outcomes

Once your team completes the *MTR-i™* course, they will be able to:

- ✓ Identify each of the eight *MTR-i™* team roles
- ✓ Understand the team contribution made by each team role
- ✓ Identify probable strengths of the team and identify ways those strengths can be built on.
- ✓ Identify potential weaknesses of the team and identify ways to mitigate those weaknesses
